# ELECTRICAL CONSTRUCTION

## AURA CIVIC SQUARE

The CV team delivered the architectural RGB lighting throughout Civic Square at Aura. The pre-programmed lighting control corresponds with world and local event colours throughout the year, allowing the square to be showered in red and green for its first Christmas.

## PRESCARE TOWNSVILLE

On track to be completed by February 2019, PresCare Townsville offers stunning views to its 140 future residents. The team is completing the electrical, communications, nurse call, fire and MATV cabling installations, along with managing the security and AV sub-contracts for the aged care facility.



## JBS HEAD OFFICE

The new head office has been completed for JBS Australia, the largest meat packer, marketer and exporter in the country. The CV team delivered the electrical installation including an Energex 500kVA pole mounted transformer feeding a Main Switchboard, distribution boards including UPS (uninterruptible power supply) distribution systems which provide uninterruptible power to computer equipment, and a master controlled lighting system including motion sensor lighting. The team also delivered data and communications cabling, access control, MATV, CCTV, and intercom and intruder system.

# ENERGY SERVICES

## DRYANDRA ROAD UNDERPASS

At Brisbane Airport, the underpass is now partially open with a public roadway travelling underneath the taxiway. The CV team delivered the street lighting, ITS and HV works on this demanding and time-sensitive project.



## SUNSHINE PLAZA

As part of Sunshine Plaza's major redevelopment, our team delivered the 11kv upgrade on the operational shopping centre. Upon completion, shoppers will enjoy 34,000sqm of additional retail space and over 1,400 more parking spaces.



## SPRINGFIELD ROAD INFRASTRUCTURE

The construction of the Springfield Southern District Sports Fields and adjacent roads is currently underway. The CV team delivered a range of electrical infrastructure for the project, including traffic signals, URD HV/LV and rate 2/3 lighting.



## HYDEBERRY DEVELOPMENT

This new development at Rochedale encompasses an 8.4ha site containing over 130 residential lots. As part of the project, the Energy Services team successfully completed the HV, LV, NBN and street lighting on time and on budget.

# ASSET SERVICES



## GOLD COAST UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL

The new patient support centre provides a facility for senior medical staff to operate out of 24/7. Interactive and real time monitoring IT systems and displays allow for timely and essential assistance to ward staff. The CV team was responsible for all works and subcontractors on site.

## BRISBANE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT

Asset Services delivered the installation of a monitored emergency lighting system for the airport. Completed in a live operational airport, our team installed over 3,100 emergency light fittings along with the supporting communications network of over 45 routers throughout the entire terminal.



## SUNSHINE COAST UNIVERSITY HOSPITAL

The CV team completed the retrofit of specialised electrical equipment and communications systems for the intensive care theatres. Completed without disturbing the operations of the live hospital, the installation provides additional capacity for operating theatres, allowing more effective patient treatment.

## VARSITY LAKES DAY HOSPITAL

New and reconfiguration works were delivered for both patient and non-patient areas, including a new Endoscope cleaning room. Maintaining a negative pressure HEPA filtered environment, the team ensured any contamination was contained, allowing three adjoining operating theatres to continue to function as usual.





# MEDIA & SIGNAGE

## DIGITAL TAXI SIGNAGE

After nearly two years of research, design, manufacturing and testing, the first digital taxi signage module is now on the road. The first of its kind in Australia, the Adflow digital signage module provides an eye-catching advertising medium.

## HOME CONSORTIUM KNOXFIELD

Former Masters centres across Victoria are being transformed by Home Consortium into retail centres. For the new centre in Knoxfield, the CV team completed internal freestanding wayfinding plinths, decals, brand discs and a 16 metre LED pylon. The external signage included large tenant LED illuminated light boxes.



## WOOLWORTHS

Ascot is home to Woolworths' most innovative store yet. With classic elements completely reinvented, the store also contains a variety of new features including a drive-through for online orders. Our team delivered the internal signage in line with the vision for a rustic marketplace design.

## WESTFIELD

Westfield Coomera is Scentre Group's first greenfield development, offering 140 stores, dining and entertainment precincts, and a purpose-built recreational park. Including the iconic red 'Westfield' lettering, the CV team delivered fabricated and illuminated lettering, centre ID signs, large scale tenant lightboxes, directional totem signs, wayfinding signs, and digital prints.
